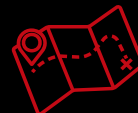

We offer modules in mathematics, physics, statistics, IT, programming, AI, data science and analytics. We also offer part-time Specialist Diplomas and short courses in data science and analytics.

In MSA, we strive to build a strong foundation in math and science and equip our students with core skills to thrive in their disciplines and prepare them for lifelong learning and evolving industry needs.

## ABOUT PFP

The PFP is a one-year diploma-specific programme that offers eligible 'N' Level (Academic) students a practice-based preparatory pathway to a polytechnic education.

From the Academic Year (AY) 2026 intake onwards, the PFP will be restructured to a cluster-based programme. Instead of entering PFP for a specific diploma, you will gain admission to the PFP in 3 broad clusters:

- Sciences (SCI)
- Humanities, Art, Media and Business (HAMB)
- Design, Engineering and Technology (DET)

After PFP, students will be posted to a specific diploma course within the cluster based on their choices and PFP results.

PFP helped many students move from secondary school to polytechnic life while making great friends.
